"The rarities cd for me is less about cleaning out the closet, and more about revealing what's in the closet. A lot of these songs were so personal to me at the time of writing them, that I just put them away with the thought that, "I'm not ready to air this out in public yet. I think of it as the difference of what you might read in a greeting card, vs. what you might write in a hand written note. The meaning is greater, and the sentiment is real."

"Chris Trapper, 37, is a singer/songwriter from Westwood, Mass., who has recorded solo as well as with his band, the Push Stars. He recently released "Songs from the Middle of the World," an acoustic solo effort of 17 "very personal" songs. It's kind of my 'Nebraska,'" he said, referring to the Bruce Springsteen recording."
